CARING FOR YOUR BAR

MAKE YOUR INVESTMENT LAST

Don't overload the bar.

This bar is designed for technique & form training. It's rated to 1200lbs maximum. Anything more than that, and you're at risk of bending or breaking this thing - neither of which are covered under warranty. You don't want to do that, do you?

Rust prevention

Special finishes like black oxide, zinc, chrome & even stainless steel help combat rust, but can't prevent it completely. After each use, wipe your bar down with a clean, dry towel. Remember, sweat is salt water and salt water is rough on metal.

Clean your bar regularly.

Use a stiff bristle brush to clean out any funk accumulated in the knurling. Chalk and dead skin can hold moisture in those little grooves, giving rust a foothold.

Rust prevention, part 2

Once you've cleaned things thoroughly, spray a little *WD-40* or *3-in-1* oil on a clean rag and wipe the entire surface of the bar, ensuring a light, even coat. Let it sit overnight, then wipe any remaining residue from the bar with a clean, dry rag.

Bushing/bearing care

Do NOT store this bar vertically, on its end. Doing so exerts forces on the bushings which can cause wear and premature failure. Always store your bushing/bearing bars horizontally, preferably on a rack.

Oil can displace the grease in your bushings/bearings!

If your bar does not have small oiling holes on the collars, keep the oil away as it can displace the grease and shorten the time before you have to really get your hands dirty.

Re-grease the bushings/bearings.

This will void the warranty, so don't attempt this until the warranty expires. (Not that you will have to in the first place!) Years from now, you may wish to open up the ends and the slip the collars off for a thorough cleaning and re-greasing. The internet is full of how to videos for this.
